#### **OUR EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY**

Baton Rouge College Prep is founded on the belief that all students can achieve at high levels. Our school design is grounded in eight core principles, based on the proven practices of the highest performing charter schools in the nation. ## **Highly Structured Environment**

At **Baton Rouge College Prep**, we know that a highly structured, disciplined, and safe school environment lays the foundation for teaching and learning to occur. To meet our high expectations, students must be able to focus on learning and teachers on teaching.

Our routines, procedures, and discipline will combine to create a school where students and teachers can focus on learning. Consistent school-wide systems and procedures will maximize instructional time. We will use our school structures and systems to guarantee that every moment of our extended day is productive to learning, from entering the building to lunch routines to dismissal, and from sharpening pencils to class participation to homework.

A clear code of conduct, enforced by all, will hold students to high behavioral expectations. Consistency matters and we will adhere to the "broken windows" approach to school discipline, in which the little things matter and infractions are addressed swiftly with teacher corrections and a merit/demerit system to decrease the likelihood of more significant negative behaviors.

Students will rise to the level of our expectations, particularly when the work is rigorous and engaging, structures and routines allow for success, and a joy for learning permeates the school. While we will relentlessly uphold a disciplined and structured environment, our classrooms and school will be infused with joy, creating a warm and strict school in which students want and choose to do what is right.

### **OUR PROGRESS**

- Our Founding Board is continuing to prepare fro the Authorizer Interview, which will take place during the last week of May.
- Three Founding Board members and Lead Founder Kathryn Rice traveled to Liberty Collegiate Academy in Nashville to observe a high-performing charter school in action. Liberty Collegiate Academy, founded in 2011 by a Building Excellent Schools Fellow, outscored both the district and the state in 2013 and had the highest student growth in Tennessee. Visiting the school prepared our team with a clear vision of how Baton Rouge College Prep can achieve the same results in 2015.
