### **OUR EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY**

Baton Rouge College Prep is founded on the belief that all students can achieve at high levels. Our school design is grounded in eight core principles, based on the proven practices of the highest performing charter schools in the nation. Each month we will highlight one of the core principles and explain how it promotes student success. This month, we highlight the fifth core principle:

- 1) High academic expectations for all
- 2) Great teachers, great results
- 3) Highly structured environment
- 4) Focused character

development

## 5) Data-driven culture

- 6) Extended learning time
- 7) Seamless grade transitions
- 8) Family involvement

### **Data-Driven Culture**

Baton Rouge College Prep will have a data-driven culture, informed by the knowledge that we must use our data to get students on and above grade level as efficiently and swiftly as possible and to assure every student is prepared for college. This means that we will constantly collect, meaningfully analyze, and strategically act on student achievement data. We will implement four essential elements of data-driven instruction:

1. Assessment - creating rigorous interim assessments



- that furnish meaningful data
- 2. *Analysis* examining the results of assessments to identify root causes of strengths and weaknesses
- 3. Action prioritizing, planning for, and effectively teaching what students most need to learn
- 4. *Culture* creating an environment in which data-driven instruction is the norm

The key to high levels of academic success for all students will be effective, targeted instruction that ensures students have the requisite skills and knowledge. Teachers will reflect on results of frequent assessments to determine appropriate interventions, ensuring that all students meet our rigorous academic expectations. Student assessment data will drive professional development, ensuring that all teachers are prepared to meet student needs.

Data Days every six weeks will be a core component of our professional development and staff culture, with teachers working in teams to analyze the data from interim assessments, plan strategically, and act rapidly to address any learning gaps. Continuous assessment of the efficiency and effectiveness of our school's operational and cultural practices will lead to adjustments that maximize student learning time and opportunity.

Our focus on student data, paired with high quality teachers, a rigorous curriculum, and support from leadership, will ensure that each individual student gets the attention s/he needs. Through our targeted action planning, we will support our students who need extra help to meet the standard, build momentum for students who are already on track, and challenge our students who are exceeding expectations.

#### **OUR PROGRESS**

- Our Board is preparing for governance while waiting for the final authorization decision from the Louisiana Board of Elementary and Secondary Education, expected in August.
- In addition to over 660 Signatures of Support, we collected our first Intent to Enroll forms from families interested in sending their child to Baton Rouge
