OUR EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY

Baton Rouge College Prep is founded on the belief that all students can achieve at high levels. Our school design is grounded in eight core principles, based on the proven practices of the highest performing charter schools in the nation. Each month we will highlight one of the core principles and explain how it promotes student success. This month, we highlight the second core principle:

Great Teachers, Great Results

At Baton Rouge College Prep, we know that phenomenal

teachers are the key to student success. We will recruit, select, train, and retain the best staff in the nation to serve our students.

We recognize that great teachers are made, not born. We will prioritize teacher development and support as the key lever to dramatically increasing student achievement. We will grow every one of our teachers, providing data-driven professional development on a weekly, monthly, quarterly, and annual basis.

Teachers will have 17 days of training in the summer to build the school team, develop curriculum, and prepare for the upcoming year. Once the school year begins, teachers will have two and a half hours of targeted professional development each week, as well as nine professional working days per year, and daily common planning time with subject and grade level teams.

Frequent classroom observations and timely face-to-face feedback will provide a continuous learning loop for rapid teacher growth. Observations and feedback meetings guided by individual and school professional goals will ensure that our teachers, students and school grow strategically.

Every teacher will be deeply committed to fulfilling our mission, to eliminating excuses for underachievement, and to working as one team to craft the environment and instruction necessary for students to meet and exceed the higher expectations of college preparation.

Our supportive, collaborative, and professional environment will allow adults to thrive, leading to retention of effective educators and ultimately driving student success.

OUR PROGRESS

- The Founding Board is preparing for the next step in our charter application - the Authorizer Interview in May.
- Kathryn Rice, Lead Founder of Baton Rouge College Prep, is gathering Letters of Support from local organizations and community leaders that will partner with the school to ensure student success.
- Ms. Rice and the Founding Board also are collecting Signatures of Support from parents, community members, and leaders in business, non-profits, religion, and education.
